**Emergency Solutions Grant Program  
Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA)**

**NOFA Date: October 17, 2012**

**Purpose:**

The Missouri Housing Development Commission (MHDC), in collaboration with the Missouri Department of Social Services hereby notifies interested organizations of the availability of funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Emergency Solutions Grant Program to provide assistance to very low-income Missourians. The funds will be allocated in a competitive process in accordance with the Allocation Plan (ESG-100). The second allocation of 2011 funds and full allocation of 2012 funds available are as indicated below:

- **\$3,372,846 from the Missouri Housing Development Commission**

**Deadline:**

Applications for funding will be accepted by MHDC until **4:30 p.m. CDT on November 26, 2012**. All **applications received after the deadline will be rejected** and returned to the sender. Decisions regarding funding of proposals are scheduled to be made by the commission in December 2012.

**Requirements:**

- Applicants must be a City/County, non-profit or partnership entity formed pursuant to applicable Missouri law, must be an entity in good standing with the state of Missouri and provide housing or housing services. Cities/Counties will have the first right of refusal before non-profits may apply directly. This list will be posted in the application guidance. **Emergency Solutions Grant monies will not be awarded to individuals.**
- All **proposals must be submitted on the current year's application form** that is posted on the MHDC website ([www.mhdc.com](http://www.mhdc.com)) and in compliance with the 2012 Application Guidance (ESG-102) also posted on the MHDC website.
- Entitlement areas are eligible to apply for \$75,000 per grant, Cities/Counties are eligible to apply for \$150,000 per grant and direct non-profits are eligible to apply for \$50,000 per grant.
