Notice of Funding Availability

HOME Repair Program

The Missouri Housing Development Commission (MHDC) hereby notifies interested applicants of the availability of funds for repair and rehabilitation of owner-occupied homes, as follows:

\$2,500,000 of Federal HOME Funds

Eligible applicants: Nonprofit agencies, regional planning commissions, and municipal entities serving all **non-metropolitan areas** of the state of Missouri. These include all communities with the exception of those in the metropolitan areas of St. Louis, Kansas City, St. Joseph, Springfield, Joplin and Columbia.

\$2,500,000 of Federal HOME Funds

Eligible applicants: Nonprofit agencies, regional planning commissions, and municipal entities serving all **DREAM** designated communities, and specifically targeting home repair in those neighborhoods immediately surrounding the core downtown areas.

This funding is available to **nonprofit agencies, regional planning commissions, and municipal entities** that will undertake the eligible activities on behalf of low- and moderate-income families in eligible areas.

Administration Costs of up to 10% of each project will be reimbursed to each agency upon the completion of each project.

Applications for funding will be accepted by MHDC until **4:30 p.m. CDT on Thursday, September 10, 2009**. Decisions regarding proposals will be made by the commission at their meeting in December 2009.
