### **Commission offers opportunity for public comments on allocation plans**

The Missouri Housing Development Commission (MHDC) will hold public hearings July 20 on modifications to the 2006 Qualified Allocation Plan (QAP) for administration of the Low Income Housing Tax Credit and the plan for administration of the Missouri Housing Trust Fund (MHTF). The QAP details how Rental Housing Tax Credits will be allocated and the procedures for the allocation. The MHTF plan discusses how funds will be allocated to agencies providing housing services. The hearings will be held at the following locations:
