**State of Missouri**  
**FY2018-2022 Draft Consolidated Plan**  
**FY2018 Draft Action Plan**

The Missouri Department of Economic Development, in conjunction with the Missouri Housing Development Commission, the Department of Health and Senior Services and the Department of Social Services, will conduct a series of public meetings and webinars beginning December 6, 2017 and ending on December 21, 2017. The meetings/webinars are regarding the FY2018 – 2022 Consolidated Plan and 2018 Action Plan.

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires the State of Missouri to publish a five-year Consolidated Plan, along with an annual "Action Plan" outlining the use of U.S. Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funds for the following programs administered by the state:

**Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG)**  
**HOME Investment Partnerships Program (MHDC)**  
**Emergency Solutions Grant Program (ESG)**  
**Housing Trust Fund Program (HTF)**  
**Housing Opportunities for Persons With AIDS (HOPWA)**  
**Balance of State Continuum of Care/McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act Funds**

These programs receive a total annual allocation of approximately \$40 million and serve the "non-entitlement" areas of the state – cities less than 50,000 in population and counties less than 200,000 in population. The State collected information on the housing, community, and economic development needs for the State of Missouri and assembled a consolidated strategic plan for 2018 - 2022. As an annual addition to this "Consolidated Plan," the FY2018 draft Action Plan must include proposed program budgets, intended use of funds, eligibility requirements, application processes, and any set-aside information. The final version of the 2018-2022 Consolidated Plan and the FY2018 Action Plan will be submitted to HUD by February 15, 2018, or at a future date as directed by HUD. The FY2018 Program Year will begin on April 1, 2018 and funds will be made available after that date.

The public is invited to review and comment on the draft 2018-2022 Consolidated Plan and the FY2018 Action Plan. Five public meetings and two webinars will be held during December 2017 regarding the Plans. During the public meetings and webinars, each program will be discussed and proposed changes will be reviewed.
