The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires the State of Missouri to publish a "Consolidated Plan" every five years and an Action Plan every year. The Consolidated Plan covers the following HUD programs administered by the State: Community Development Block Grant, HOME Program, Emergency Shelter Grant Program, Housing Trust Fund, Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS, and the Continuum of Care.

The current Consolidated Plan was adopted in 2013 and is in effect through 2017. The new five-year consolidated plan will cover the years 2018-2022. Staff from these programs must collect information about the housing, community and economic development needs for the State and assemble a plan for meeting those needs over the next five years. Part of that information must come from public input. This meeting is an opportunity for interested persons to contribute to the preliminary planning process. During the meeting, staff will present an outline of what is required for the plan, offer preliminary ideas for assembling the data, and ask attendees for input and suggestions.

Once the draft 2018-2022 Consolidated Plan and the 2018 Action Plan is published and distributed in December, additional public meetings will be conducted for further input. If you have any questions about this process, please contact Marcy Oerly at 573-751-3600 or marcy.oerly@ded.mo.gov.
